## Student Engagement



Students will be taking notes based on information presented by Partner A. As Partner A preps, Partner B engages students in a physical activity designed to help them connect to the concept. Partner A completes prepping and talks with Partner B about the ongoing physical activity. Partner A validates the strategy and incorporates it into the presentation. Concept-Biology-Buildup of lactic acid in the muscles. Physical activity-holding non dominant arm out to the side while waiting to take notes.

ACTION: Engage students by increasing relevance of instruction.
