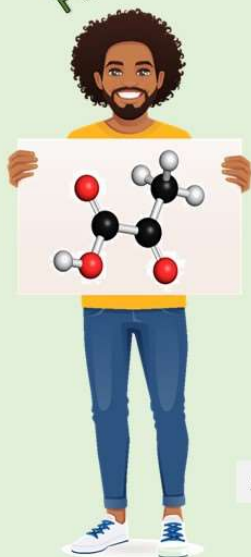


## Teacher Engagement

Partner A has provided Partner B a rough sketch of the chemical structure of a molecule (pyruvate) prior to the lesson. As Partner A describes step-by-step how the molecule is formed, Partner B creates a visual model as a guide for students. Partner A circulates and monitors students as they create their model of the molecule.



**ACTION:** Provide partner with content-based support to facilitate shared participation.

Some coordination and/or advanced planning may be required.

This strategy provides Partner B with the content knowledge needed to actively participate in instruction. By assuming the responsibility for visual modeling, Partner B enables Partner A to focus on providing an accurate verbal description to students. Partners will have to coordinate their input to insure a smooth presentation.
