CO-TEACH PLAY # 14



Partner B usually enters the classroom during homework review but does not actively participate in evaluating student responses. As a result, Partner A manages most of the interaction with students during that phase of instruction. To facilitate Partner B's participation, Partner A provides an answer key to the homework, showing correct solutions. Partner B now has access to correct content and can engage with students.



ACTION: Provide partner with content-based support to facilitate shared participation.

Some coordination and/or advanced planning may be required.
