Partner A's question results in several students misunderstanding it and providing inaccurate responses. The students attempt to justify their responses, based on the wording of the question, and a non-productive discussion ensues. Partner B analyzes the cause of the misunderstanding, assumes the lead, and offers a rewording of the question. Both partners agree on the revision and acknowledge that the original question caused confusion.

ACTION: Monitor and clarify verbal input to students.

Some coordination and/or advanced planning may be required.
