

## Student to Teacher Communication

Partner B observes that a student is struggling to respond to a question posed by Partner A. Partner B interjects, providing non-verbal cues and several leading questions. After prompting, the student responds correctly to the question and Partner A validates the student's answer.



**ACTION:** Provide assistance when students encounter difficulties with oral communication.
