

## Student to Student Communication

Before releasing students to begin working in groups, partners role-play some of the communication behaviors that students should exhibit while working together. These behaviors include turn taking, active listening and questioning techniques.



**ACTION:** Model appropriate communication behaviors to facilitate student to student communication.

Some coordination and/or advanced planning may be required.

Student to student communication is most productive when all students can join the conversation. Instituting expectations can empower students who may not usually assert themselves. It may also prevent other students from monopolizing the conversation. A second teacher in the room supports modeling of communication and other behaviors as well.
