As one partner calls students' names, the other moves to the location in the room where those students will work with their group. Roles are exchanged partway through the process.

By cooperating to manage change in the learning environment, partners reduce the time needed to effect those changes. This promotes flexibility, a prerequisite for implementing instruction that better meet the needs of more students. Exchanging roles also communicates to students that both teachers support the new structure of the classroom.
